

## PRESENTATION

The **European Federation of Rural Tourism** (*EuroGites*) is a professional tourism trade organisation that represents a tourism sector with an estimate of **500.000 micro-enterprises** and about **5-6,5 million bed places.** It is formed by 31 professional and trade organisations from 28 countries<sup>1</sup> of geographical Europe. The product includes from the rural Bed&Breakfast and self-catering in private homes or farms up to small family-run rural hotels or guesthouses, as well as restaurant or activity tourism services. As a whole, this sector stands for about **15% of the European tourism capacity.** 

The objectives of EuroGites are wide-spread, given the transversal character of this sector that requires support and representation in multiple areas. Our statutes define the main tasks and activities of the Federation as follows:

- information and communication network amongst the member organisations and on international level
- professional representation in European organisations (private and public)
- harmonisation of information content and terminology
- definition of common quality criteria and standards, with the final objective of a common branding and marketing on European level
- professional and vocational training, research

At the **European Union**, EuroGites represents rural tourism in the Civil Dialogue Group on Rural Development of the European Commission, and in several ad-hoc committees and work groups on specific matters related with the areas of our activity. We are also active member of several European umbrella organisations such as *European Movement for Rurality (MER)*, *NET*, and *Tourism Manifesto*.

For common **promotion**, access to the member websites is linked through the site <u>www.eurogites.org</u> General recommendations for a Europe-wide product definition and minimum quality standards in rural tourism accommodation were formally approved, online benchmarking is available at <u>http://guality.eurogites.org</u>

EuroGites is also responsible for the **European Congress on Rural Tourism.** Five such events were organized since 2003 in different countries of Europe, the 6<sup>th</sup> edition will take place 3-5<sup>th</sup>/October/2018 in **Lithuania.** We were also co-organiser of the conference **STRD2017-Sustainable Tourism for Rural Development** <u>http://strd2017.org</u> in February 2017.
